
Dear colleagues,

- Abstract length should not exceed 1 page.
- Text editor Microsoft Word.
- 3. File format - doc.
- Font: Times New Roman.12 pt., line spacing: 1.0. margins: top 3 cm (1.18"), bottom 2.7 cm (1.06"), left and right 2 cm (0.79"), text should be justified without hyphenations, first line indent - 0.5 cm (0.20") (page size A4. formatted in 2 columns).
- Chemical formulas should be drawn in ISIS Draw 2.4, or ChemDraw. Schemes must be made taking into account the following reduction in size in the book of abstracts (see instructions).
- 6. Example:
 - **TITLE** (14 pt., in bold, centered)
 - Last name and initials: Johnson, J. J. (12 pt. centered)
 - Affiliation and Mailing address (10 pt, in italic, centered)
